Most of the juniors are down here for the Marine Corps clinic and small arms firing school. It's shaping up to be another wonderful year.




NRA-ILA **Wisconsin Gun Laws**

The people have the right to keep and bear arms for security, defense, hunting, recreation or any other lawful purpose.




